OPERATION ORDER No. 24.

Apr. 1st, 1917.

1. The 4th. Canadian Battalion will be relieved by the 2nd. Canadian Battalion on the night of Apr. 1st./2nd.
2. On completion of relief the 4th. Battalion will be in Brigade Support at MAISON BLANCHE.
3. Units of the 4th. Cdn. Inf. Bn. will occupy dug outs vacated by corresponding Units of the 1st. Cdn. Inf. Bn.
4. Trench Stores, etc. will be handed over and receipts obtained; duplicates to be sent to Orderly Room by 6.00 a.m. Apr. 2nd.
5. A certificate of Trench Stores taken over at MAISON BLANCHE will be rendered to Orderly Room by 6.00 a.m. Apr. 2nd.
6. Disposition reports to be in Orderly Room by 6.00 a.m. Apr. 2nd.
7. All trenches will be left in a clean and sanitary condition; certificates will be obtained to that effect and sent to Orderly Room by 6.00 a.m. Apr. 2nd.
8. Lewis & Colt Guns will be carried out.
9. Very Pistols and Periscopes are to be taken out.
10. Completion of relief to be notified to Battalion H.Q. by wire, using the phrase, - "YOUR No. 2 RECEIVED."
