Operation Order No. 27

Apr. 20th, 1917.

1. The 4th. Cdn. Inf. Bn. will relieve the left Company of the 15th. Cdn. Inf. Bn. in the front line, the South Company along the railway line and the two Companies in FARBUS WOOD of the 16th Cdn. Inf. Bn.
2. Distribution of Companies will be detailed at BOIS GARRE it will probably be, -
 A Farbus Wood.
 B Left Company.
 C Farbus Wood
 D South Company.
3. The 4th. Cdn. Inf. Bn. will assemble at BOIS GARRE.
4. Units will move off independently, interval of One Hundred yards between platoons and be clear of present billets by 12.00 noon the 21st. April.
5. Lewis & Colt Guns to be ready for transport by 8.30 a.m.
6. Blankets to be rolled and tagged as usual and be ready for transport by 12 noon.
7. Mens packs to be ready for transport by 12. noon.
8. Officers kits to be ready for transport by 12 noon.
9. No transportation for Officers Trench Kits available to-morrow.
10. Field Kitchens will be at BOIS GARRE and a hot meal will be served about 5.00 p.m. to-morrow the 21st. April.
11. Ration dump will be at BOIS GARRE.
12. Marching out state to be rendered to Orderly Room by 10.00 a.m.
13. Certificate to Orderly Room that billets are in a clean and sanitary condition by 12 noon.
14. All trench stores taken over must be carefully checked and copies sent to Bn. H.Q. soon as possible.
15. Disposition reports to be in Bn. H.Q. soon as possible.
16. Relief reports to Battalion Orderly Room soon as possible.
17. Brigade Headquarters will be at ROSEN HAUS A.16.c.8.9 $\frac{1}{2}$.
18. Battalion Headquarters will be notified later.
19. Officers chargers will be at Bn. H.Q. at 11.30 a.m.
20. Advance party as already detailed.
